- publicly available and addressed to anyone with an interest in the company's activities and the way it does business


Code of ethics or a code of conduct?



- generally addressed to and intended for employees alone
- is mainly defined for the acceptable and unacceptable actions
- more compliance or rule focused
- has precised elements



- ✓ to ensure better accountability in the administration
- ✓ to have a good governance for the betterment of people/employees
- ✓ to maintain highest ethical standards in the organization
- ✓ to have better consultation, communication and cooperation among the various parts of the organization
